What a busy Emmaus month May has been. The month began with Women's Walk FE-83 Closing at Camp Happyland on May 1st – good job WLD Susan Dillard!!!

Your Team Selection Committee met on May 12 and May 19 to identify Teaming Candidates for our Fall Walks FE-84 and FE-85. WLDs Harry Tillman and Lola McDonald joined with TSC members Pastor Joe Reed, Dawn Kendall, Tim Patrick, Susan Dillard, Kitti Mann and Art Blankenship as together we identified all current teamers, discussed where they are in their assignment progression, and agreed upon a call priority for the WLDs to use as they recruit. With Board approval of Team call priorities, recruitment will begin. As soon as the Teams are recruited, the TSC will meet to make Team assignments. Our Community's first joint Men & Women Team Orientation has been scheduled for Friday, August 26 at Fairview Charlotte Street and will serve as the kickoff of our Fall Teaming activity.

May 14th was very special as we held the 4th Day Follow-up training, then our Board meeting and finally the Gathering. 4th Day Follow-up training was well attended – much thanks Sponsors who brought their Pilgrims and to Pastor Joe, Mike Remington, Kitti Mann and Art Blankenship for helping me with instruction, survey and audio/video support during the three hour program.

The May Board meeting actions included approval of the Team FE-84 candidates and call priority, approval of the WLD recommendations for Spring 2012 Walks, concurrence that Gathering site Points of Contact need a checklist of responsibilities, approval of the list of Board nominees and the election process for June Gathering, and receipt and discussion of a letter to the Board from Pastor Mark Dunn regarding Upper Room changes in Community Spiritual Director qualifications that became effective recently.

The May Gathering at Stafford Crossing included introductions of all Board Nominees standing for election in June, our new Board Spiritual Director Pastor Jim Muhlenkamp, and the Pilgrims from Women's Spring Walk FE-83 who reported out their 4th Day experience since their Walk.

How about June? Well, it will be busy too! Your Team Selection Committee will meet to make assignments for our Fall Walks, the Board will meet to elect officers for the coming year, and the Community will Gather to elect our new Board members for the coming year. Regarding Board elections – we have eight positions that need to be filled through the election process – that is a whole new Board majority – a big deal!

**Please participate in the Board election process by absentee ballot or in person at the Gathering on Saturday, June 11 at Dahlgren UMC – Fellowship at 3:30 PM and Gathering at 4 PM.**

Finally, on a personal note, this is my final report to you as your Community Lay Director. I have been fortunate to serve our Emmaus Community twice as your Lay Director over the years and cannot think of a service experience that has brought me more joy. # From The Community Spiritual Director

As I bring my tour as your Community Spiritual Director to a close, please allow me the opportunity to say “thanks” for the chance to minister across our community of faith. There have been good days and there have been challenging days, but overall the good days far outweigh the challenges. We have made significant improvements in aligning our community with the spiritual intent of the Upper Room manual. Criticism from the body of Christ often times has not been constructive, and when it was not, it emotionally frustrated us. We must always remember that when we allow love, acceptance and forgiveness to flourish, we can experience the fullness of God’s agape.

Change can be good, but I would caution that too much change, although coupled with good intention, can “stress” the greater whole. Additionally, we must honestly admit that through the years we have drifted from the intent of the model and have become weekend-focused instead of community-focused. Although some necessary corrective measures, admittedly painful at times, have been initiated, these cost associated with the changes has been great. Some have departed our community; others have developed a wait-and-see mentality. Nonetheless, through prayer and spiritual resolve, we have forged ahead. Again, I say that God has not withdrawn His hand.

The Upper Room Walk To Emmaus has developed stringent clergy criteria. Future Community Spiritual Directors will have to hold a Master in Divinity (M.Div.) degree or have completed an advanced study program at the graduate level approved by their denomination/church. Additionally, clergy desiring to serve as Weekend Spiritual Directors must attend Upper Room Clergy Training. These are but some of the challenges your Community Spiritual Director has faced. This is why it is imperative that we have increased clergy participation. I continue to covet your prayers in this regard.

I am pleased to announce the Emmaus Introductory Forum scheduled for Saturday, 25 June at First Christian Church, Fredericksburg from 11 am – 1 pm. This forum is designed for clergy who have not attended a Walk To Emmaus and are unfamiliar with the Emmaus movement. Invitation letters will only be sent to clergy who have not attended a Walk To Emmaus. Community members are free to invite interested clergy to this event. ## Emmaus Board Nominees - Biographical Introductions

### Ava Hanger - Dahlgren UMC

My name is Ava Hanger; I worship at Dahlgren United Methodist Church. I walked Fredericksburg Emmaus #69 and sat at the table of Peace.

I am a full-time mother of two elementary school children. This is my full-time, no-breaks ministry. Raising thoughtful, Christian children has its challenges, but it has great rewards, too. I've been very blessed that my daughter loves the Emmaus community as much as I do, and it's something we've been able to share. She usually joins me at the monthly gatherings, (she's the cute one). Last year, I was elected to serve a one-year term left vacant on the Emmaus board, and I felt led to continue my willingness to serve if chosen by the community. I serve my church in various capacities, such as treasurer for the Scrip committee, (a fundraising effort), music and drama ministries, and, newly, teaching a middle school Sunday School class. I'm involved in a weekly Accountability Group, as well as a weekly Bible study. I also volunteer with the Salvation Army Women's Auxiliary and participate in a local, monthly youth rally in King George called Mars Hill, singing and playing in the band.

### Bill Walker - Senior Pastor, Epworth UMC

Bill Walker, worship and serve at Epworth UMC in Aylett, VA, walked on FE 51, Table of Matthew. Since I walked I've served on 10 teams as a layperson, filling the role of an Assistant Table Leader, Table Leader, Musician, and Music Director. I even received my call to ordained ministry while on the team for FE55, which led me to retire in 2008 from the Navy, enroll full-time at Wesley Theological Seminary, and begin the candidacy process for ordainment in the United Methodist Church. Since then I have been appointed as a Full-time Local Pastor at Epworth UMC, graduated from Wesley with a Masters of Divinity degree, and been approved for provisional ordination in the UMC, which will take place next month. I've also teamed as a Spiritual Director on FE80 and FE82.

I am a strong believer in the Emmaus movement, not only for what it has done for me, but also for all the changes I've seen in many who have walked. As a pastor, I believe that my active support for Emmaus is the best testimony of encouragement I can give. This support includes sponsoring, serving on teams, and serving on the board.

## Chris Campbell - Fairview at River Club

I have worshipped at Fairview at River Club since its opening 3 years ago and was ordained as a deacon in May. Previously I attended Fairview Baptist Church and Riverview Baptist Church. I am a small-group leader in my church and am active in an Emmaus reunion group that meets weekly. I walked on FE-70, (sat at the Table of Peter), have teamed three times, and have been a community servant many times. I have 4 children, two of which will be at Liberty University this fall. ## Tom Dempsey - First Christian Church
