### Thoughts from the Lay Director...

Someone recently emailed one of those cute stories to me that you just don't know whether to believe or not. Whether it is true or not, may not be important, because in this case and in some others they teach a good lesson or give us something to ponder about our own lives. Such was the case this time. This one was called the Ant and the Contact lens.

If you haven't seen the story, I'll give you the short version. A young lady went rock climbing for the first time with some friends. About half way up the rock face she is taking a break on a ledge and the rope strikes her in the face causing her contact lens to become dislodged and it falls apparently back to the base of the cliff. This causes her great distress because now, what had started as a beautiful experience has been clouded by her loss. Not only the expense of replacing the lenses but now everything is blurry and a big part of this trip was enjoying the beauty of nature. So she prays, "Lord help me find my contact lens."

It is not until she has descended to the ground and the next group of rock climber's approach that her prayer is answered. Someone notices that an ant is carrying a contact lens across the face of a boulder. Well sure enough it is her contact lens. But then the story gets better. The author switches to what the ant might be thinking... God, why do you want me to carry this thing? I can't eat it; it doesn't make good nesting material and weighs more than I do. But if you want me to carry it I will.

The moral of the story is clear. Sometimes God asks us to do tasks that we really would rather leave to someone else. But in His infinite wisdom He has selected you or me to participate in His plan. We will receive a blessing or be a blessing to someone else if we are just obedient and stop complaining and do what is asked. Are you carrying a burden today that you just don't know why? No matter how much you try God won't let you out of it? Your not alone, many of us are. Look around; you might be surprised who is being blessed by it.

Emmaus can be like this sometimes. We just don't quite understand why we are doing some of the things we are doing, but people are getting blessed by it, in spite of us, not necessarily because of us.

### Board News...

The Board of Directors met at Fairview Baptist Church immediately before the Gathering on September 9th 2006.

Monica Warne reported we needed to get our dates for 2008 penciled in for Camp Happyland as the camp is becoming better known and a popular meeting place. The following dates were chosen on contingency:

2008 Spring Men's Walk March 6-9 or 27-30 as second choice

2008 Spring Women's Walk April 24-27

2008 Fall Men's Walk October 16-19

2008 Fall Women's Walk November 13-16

Deposits will have to be made to Camp Happyland in February as they open their 2008 calendar.

The Board gave approval to act on an earlier vote to purchase wireless microphones for the speakers and music teams to use on the upcoming walks and gathering. Monica reported we had funds set aside in the budget for the purchase of that equipment and it was now available. The Board agreed not to exceed \$800.00 on the purchase.

We continued receiving reports from volunteers so the Board could see how they might help them and to understand what is involved in each volunteer position. Brooke Ferguson gave a report on the newsletter.

Dick Barnett and Terry Cook gave reports from the 4th Day Ministry. Terry Cook gave the overview and recommendations of the Teaming and Training work group. The Board voted to accept those as presented. We believe this will help all future Weekend Lay Directors to better prepare for their walks and give more uniformity to the process.

Dick Barnett gave the Gathering and DDU work group report and recommendations. The Board also voted to accept these as presented. We will be incorporating DDU into the Gathering and making it a more streamlined process giving much of the information in printed handout form. Also we are going to present a DDU once each calendar quarter to give everyone a chance to attend one to fulfill teaming and sponsoring requirements.

I believe some of these changes might be a little difficult to get into place at first; but once the "bugs" get worked out they will have a very positive affect on the Community.

7310A Old Plank Rd Fredericksburg, Virginia

From 95/Central Park Exit:

Head west on Route 3 for approximately 5 miles. Turn left onto Andora Drive and take to end. Turn right onto Old Plank Road. The church will be within 100 yards ahead.
