#### From the Community Spiritual Director...

In Philippians, the 2nd Chapter, verses 1-3, Paul makes an appeal for unity based on common devotion to Christ and common possession of the Holy Spirit. Although the church at Philipi was exemplary in many respects, and Paul often commended them, there was an undercurrent of strife within the church. But they had Christ, as we do in Emmaus. I think there is a message for us here. As we welcome a new Emmaus Board and begin to form new teams for the fall walks, we should maintain a unity of purpose. We read the purpose of Emmaus at the beginning of each board meeting. We can maintain this unity "by being like-minded, having the same love, and being of one accord and of one word". Does this mean we have to think and act alike? I don't think so. We may disagree on minor things, (uniformity and unity are not the same), but we should agree on the purpose of Emmaus and the principle of progressive servanthood. To be like-minded really means to have the mind of Christ, to see things as He would see them, and to respond as He would respond. To have the same love means to show the same love to others as our Lord has shown to us. To be of one accord means to act in a united way so as to show that Christ's mind is directing our activities. The evil one does not want us to have the mind of Christ. He desires disunity among us. He wants us to have selfish ambition. He doesn't want us to work toward a common goal. He doesn't want us to be indwelt and empowered by the Holy Spirit. He wants contention and strife. My friends, let's approach our purpose with the mind of Christ, to love others as Christ loved us, and to work together as brothers and sisters in Christ.
